### NOTE TO APPLICANT:

All applicants MUST have bill paid before the next bill comes out in order to keep the assistance going for the full 4 months. All applicants MUST provide SSI or SSDI verification to the City of Ottawa Utility Department. You may obtain this information from the Social Security Office by calling 1-800-772-1213 or calling their Lawrence office at 1-866-698-2561.

\*The Winter Assistance Program is subject to annual review
