Hickory Street, Ottawa 66067 until 10:00 a.m. on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022. The project consists of constructing a Gravity Sewer, Pump Station and Force Main in Ottawa, Kansas. No Bidder may withdraw his proposed Bid for a period of Sixty (60) days after the date and hour set for the opening of Bids.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive formalities in considering Bids and to accept the Bid which in its opinion is the best Bid. The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.
