REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL
ANALYSIS OF THE CONDITION OF WATER TREATMENT FACILITY

Requests for proposals will be received until **9:00 am on Monday July 17, 2023.**

GENERAL INTENT:

Proposals are being requested for analysis of the condition of the current city owned water treatment facility.

The City of Ottawa Water Treatment Plant is a surface water plant with a designed capacity of 5.8 MGD and a regulatory reduction capacity of 4.8 MGD. The treatment plant is a class IV plant with conventional filtration. Chemicals used for treatment are chlorine gas, liquid ammonium sulfate, quicklime, polymer, powder activated carbon, and hydrofluosilicic acid. Plant average production per day is 1.5 MGD.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- Work to begin following execution of contract.
- Certificate of Liability Insurance will be required prior to work beginning.
- Expected duration of contract not to exceed 120 days.
