Rezone Procedures & Application

A proposal for a change in district classification (rezoning) may be initiated by the owner of the property affected, the City Commission, or the Planning Commission.

The applicant shall first obtain the proper application from the office of Community Development Department and receive a complete explanation of its requirements. The applicant may wish to discuss various zoning options and requirements for the property in question with one of the city planners. Applicants may obtain all the necessary forms from the Community Development Department or the city's website. www.ottawaks.gov

The application form shall be completely filled out and returned to the office of Community Development Department with the appropriate filing fee and, evidence of ownership and other required information.

The applicant is responsible to submit the required ownership list of the names and addresses of the owners of all property located within two hundred (200) feet of the city limits and within one thousand (1,000) feet of the county boundaries, excluding rights-of-way, of the property included in the application. The applicant can obtain this list from one of the title companies or the Franklin County Appraiser's Office.

The Community Development Department shall then schedule a public hearing at the next available time of the Planning Commission. Not less than (20) twenty days prior to the Planning Commission meeting, and official notice to the public shall be published in the official city newspaper explaining the rezone request and the time and place of the scheduled public hearing. The Community Development Department shall mail a written notice to each party of interest and each person on the ownership list twenty (20) days prior to the public hearing. This notice shall also notify surrounding property owners of their right to file protest petitions and shall explain the protest procedure.

The public hearing may be adjourned from time to time and upon its conclusion, the Planning Commission shall prepare and adopt its recommendation to the Governing Body. This recommendation along with an accurate record of the public hearing, shall be submitted to the Governing Body for action.
